Who Benefits from MCH Home Care Services?

- Pregnant women: uncomplicated and high risk
- Postpartum mothers who continue to require support through the lactation period
- Newborns both healthy and high risk
- Children 0-18 with a medical problem
- Families needing instruction in child care and parenting

Purpose:

- Assist mothers and children to remain at home with their families
- Provide home and community based maternal child health services to children, families and public groups
- Provide ante partum home based monitoring including fetal heart tones and blood pressure monitoring.

Types of Care Provided by Visiting Nurse Association of Pottstown & Vicinity

ANTEPARTUM CARE

Assisting mothers experiencing a high risk or complicated pregnancy to prevent or control complications and remain at home.

POST PARTUM/NEWBORN CARE

Assisting mothers post delivery to adapt to their new role, through assessment of mother and newborn with a focus on education and support.

NEONATAL/PEDIATRIC CARE

Assisting children with complex medical needs, and their families to remain independent in their home. Services may include high tech skills such as electronic monitoring, and Phototherapy.

CHILDHOOD IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM

Immunization clinics provide vaccines against vaccine preventable diseases to children birth through 18 years of age who have no health insurance or are underinsured. Funded by PA Department of Health, there is no charge for the vaccines. Immunization clinics are held year round at the Visiting Nurse Association of Pottstown & Vicinity's office twice a month.

Each Visiting Nurse Association of Pottstown & Vicinity Specialty Service Includes:

- Case Coordination with comprehensive assessment and establishment of a plan of care in collaboration with the physician, other providers, family, and the client.
- Maternal/Child Health Home Care Services that are available, but not limited to, the following:

 - Infusion Therapy
 - Respite Care Services
 - Homemaking Services
 - Medical Social Work
 - Psychiatric/Mental Health Services

 - Physical Therapy
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Speech Therapy
 - Private Duty Services
 - Pediatric Palliative Care
 - Education resource to client and family
 - Linkage with community resources
 - Client advocacy
